Light at the end of the Broadband Tunnel!!

One of the few drawbacks of living in Hankerton is access to usable broadband bandwidth. The distance from the exchange in Crudwell means that, even with the introduction of fibre optic service, the bandwidth we will see in Hankerton will NOT increase to the level many anticipate. There is however 'light at the end of the tunnel'. I have recently had discussions with Cotswold Wireless on the possibility of getting their wireless broadband installed at home. The survey revealed that we had inadequate signal strength from their transmitter on Braydon water tower. Cotswold Wireless raised the possibility of setting up a relay in the village using a suitable location such as the church tower. This solution is not as cheap as standard broadband however it will deliver data rates of between 10-20 Mb.
